Gm7 (measures 7-8): Measure 7 contains a quarter note F3 (fingered 3), a quarter note E3 (fingered 2), a quarter note D3 (fingered 1), and a quarter note C3 (fingered 3). Measure 8 contains a quarter note B2 (fingered 2), a quarter note A2 (fingered 1), a quarter note G2 (fingered 2), and a quarter note F2 (fingered 1).

Cm7 (measures 9-10): Measure 9 contains a quarter note E2 (fingered 2), and a quarter rest. Measure 10 contains a quarter note D2 (fingered 3), and a quarter rest.
